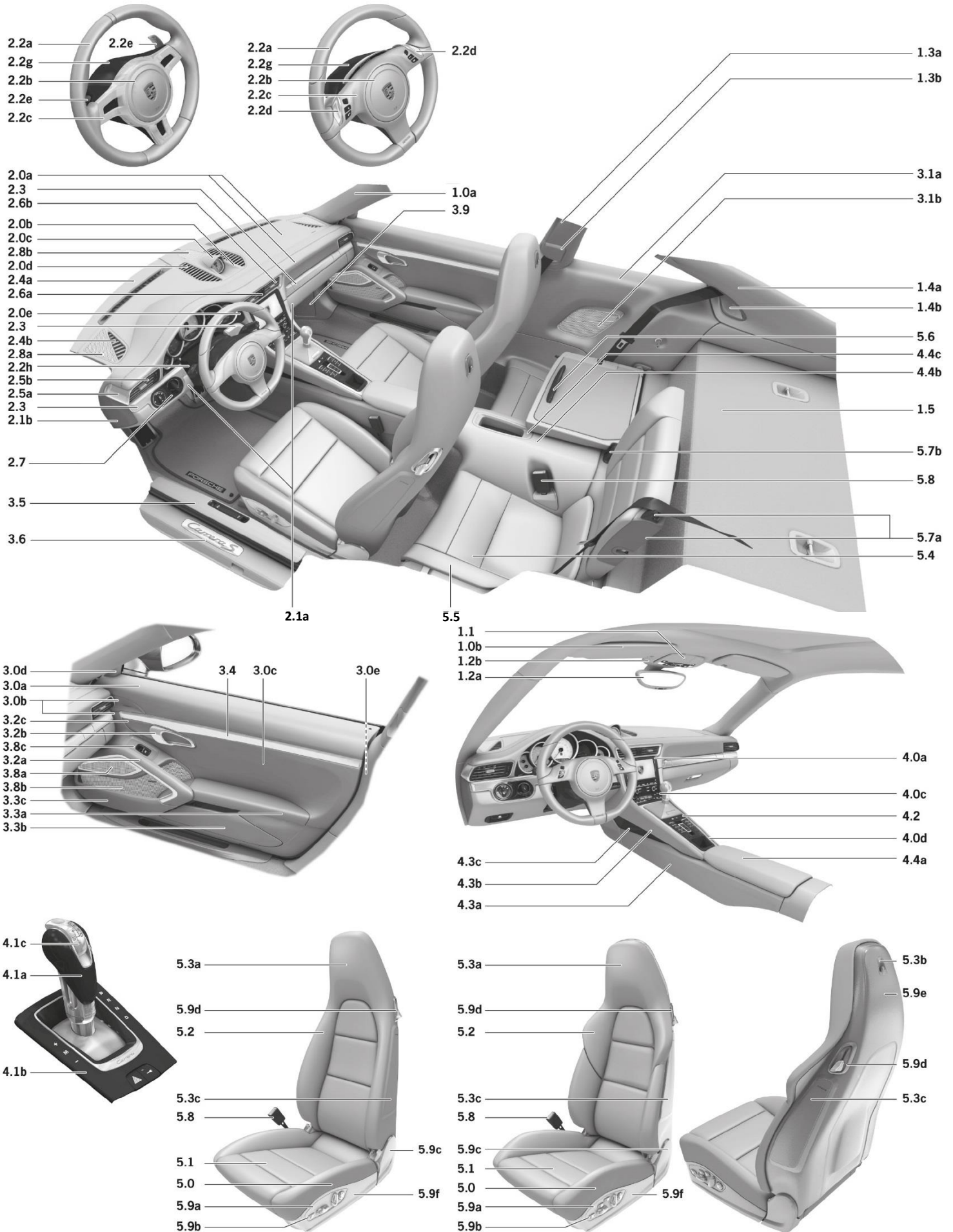


Porsche 991 leather interiors explained



Partial leather seats

(standard on all 991 Carrera models, only available on Power Sport seats 4-way or 14-way with memory package)

- **Covered in grained leather:**
 - o Front seat centers (5.1)
 - o Front side bolsters (5.2)
 - o Front headrests (5.3a)
- **Covered in smooth-finish leather:**
 - o Steering wheel rim (2.2a)
 - o Door handles (3.2a)
 - o Door armrests (3.3a),
 - o Center console storage compartment cover (4.4a),
 - o Gearshift lever (4.1a)
- **Covered in Alcantara:**
 - o C-pillar (1.4a)

Leather seats *(available on all seats)*

Includes in addition to "Partial leather seats":

- **Covered in smooth-finish leather:**
 - o Front seat centers (5.1)
 - o Front side bolsters (5.2)
 - o Front headrests (5.3a)
 - o Lower part seat (5.0)
 - o Rear seat centers (5.4)
 - o Rear seat bolsters (5.5)
 - o Rear center tunnel (4.4b)
 - o Backrest front seats*

**Only for Sport seats (4-way & 14-way). For "Sport seats plus" and "Adaptive Sport seats plus", there's a separate option (XWK) needed.*

Leather interior *(available on all seats)*

Includes in addition to "Leather seats":

- **Covered in smooth-finish leather:**
 - o Upper part dashboard (2.0a) *(excluding: dashboard end trim, windshield defroster panel, side defroster vents and center dashboard upper section trim. To cover these parts in leather, there's a separate option (CWK) needed.*
 - o Airbag cover steering wheel (2.2b)
 - o Lower part dashboard (2.1a)
 - o Upper door trim (3.0a)
 - o Center part door panel (3.0c)
 - o Center console side trim (4.3b)
 - o Rear side panels (3.1a)
- **Covered in Alcantara:**
 - o A-pillar (1.0a)
 - o B-pillar (1.3a)

Option XWK Sports seats plus backrest shells in Leather *(available on Sport seats plus & Adaptive sport seats plus)*

- **Covered in smooth-finish leather in interior color with decorative stitching in matching color:**
 - o Sports seats plus backrest shells (5.9e)
 - o Coathook on seat backrests (5.3b)
 - o Baseplate backrest release (5.9d)
 - o Plating trim (5.3c)
 - o Seat console (5.9f)

Why are the 18-way seats \$50 cheaper than the 14-way seats, when you opt for the “leather seats” option?

The 18-way seats come standard with the option “leather seats”. They are not available in “partial leather seats”. The cost for the 18-way seats themselves is \$3825, with no additional cost for the option “leather seats”. (The backrest shells are NOT covered in leather on the 18-way seats) The 14-way seats come standard as “partial leather seats” and cost \$2320. The additional cost for the option “leather seats” is \$1555.

Option “Leather seats”

18-way seats: $3825 + 0 = 3825$

14-way seats: $2320 + 1555 = \underline{3875}$
- 50

Okay I get it...

But why are the 18-way seats \$1145 more expensive than the 14-way seats, when you opt for “full leather interior” option?

The additional cost for “Full leather interior”, for both seats is \$3690. However, Porsche reduced the price of the 18-way seats by \$360 because the backrest shells are not covered in leather on these seats.

Option “Full leather interior”

18-way seats: $3465 + 3690 = 7155$

14-way seats: $2320 + 3690 = \underline{6010}$
+ 1145
